Minutes:

Supervisor Savitsky motioned to waive the reading aloud of and accept the minutes of the April 18, 2011 Township Meeting, Bill Wicks 2nd, All in Favor.

Financial Report/Presentation of Bills

Mike Savitsky reviewed the financial reports and the bills. **Mo. by Savitsky, 2nd by Wicks to pay the bills and accept the financial reports as presented. All in Favor.**

Hickory Ridge Sewer: Mike reported that they are still working out a few details.

Abington Little League Presentation: John Cuck from the Abington Little League (LL) gave a presentation of facts about the LL. About 3.5% of the children are from Glenburn. The LL has purchased the land and built the fields without any funding from any Government agency. They collect most of their money from registration fees and concession stands. They are looking to the various townships to help out with the expenses. They have \$440,000 left on the \$700,000 mortgage plus ongoing expenses for maintaining the fields, etc. Supervisor Savitsky said that Glenburn would take his request under consideration.

Roads: Bill Wicks read the road report. The road crew has been pot hole patching various township roads. They cleaned up after the storms on April 26th and 28th. They also have done crack sealing on Waterford Road, Summerfield Drive and Forest Glen Circle.
