Minutes:

Supervisor Savitsky motioned to waive the reading aloud of and accept the minutes of the September 16, 2013 Township Meeting, Supervisor Wicks 2nd, All in Favor.

Financial Report/Presentation of Bills

Mo. by Savitsky 2nd by Jennings to pay the bills and accept the financial reports as presented. All in Favor. Prior Mo. approving all the bills for September 2013 and October 2013 rescinded. Mo. by Savitsky to approve all bills except SEO Redel's Bills, 2nd by Bill Wicks, all in Favor. Mo. by Mike Savitsky 2nd by Bill Wicks to approve revised SEO bills of 19 hours for September 2013 and 18 hours for October 21. All in Favor.

Colombo Pine Tree Drive Subdivision: The variance request by Frank Colombo for the frontage on his Pine Tree Drive subdivision has been approved by the Zoning Hearing Board. Mo. By Savitsky, 2nd by Wicks to approve the Colombo Pine Tree Drive subdivision. All in Favor.

Hickory Ridge Sewer: Malcolm reported that the draft of the ARWA agreement has been revised and he will meet with Attorney Donohue to discuss. Hopefully it will be done for the next meeting.

Committee Reports

Police: Chief James reported that things were quiet in the Township. Mike Savitsky asked about the backdrops that the shooters in Mr. Menendez's neighborhood had been using. Chief James said that Angelo had a call into them and was waiting for a call back. He also said that things appeared to be in order.

Roads: Bill read the road report left by Road Master Mennig. The F550 got new rear seals and rotors, a lower radiator hose and new coolant. Ditch repair was done to roads damaged from 2 heavy rain events. A new grading bucket was purchased from Medico and used on the 8 ton patch job on Fords Pond Road. Lower Waterford Road, Gideon Lane and Tourist Ave. were regraded. The ditch running from Condella's down to the crossover pipe on Lower Waterford Road was cleaned out. Leaf cleanups are being done every day.

Sewage Enforcement: No report

Code Enforcement: No activity. Tom Wicks will look into the Edwards Avenue Complaint.

Planning: No activity.

Recreation: Bill Wicks reported that they are finishing up the grant. They need to do some work on the parking areas as there is much overflow parking.
