GLENBURN TOWNSHIP LACKAWANNA COUNTY, PA RESOLUTION NO. 02 - 2011

A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE CHARGED IN CONNECTION WITH THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT, INCLUDING APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS TO INSTALL, MODIFY, REPAIR AND REPLACE ON-SITE SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES, AND SITE SUITABILITY EVALUATIONS, MINOR SUBDIVISION REVIEWS, MAJOR SUBDIVISION REVIEWS, SOIL REPLACEMENT VERIFICATION AND APPEALS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF GLENBURN.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Glenburn Township (the "Board") has enacted an Ordinance establishing procedures in connection with the application for, issuance of permits to install on-site sewage facilities and related work in the Township of Glenburn, Lackawanna County, and

WHEREAS, the Board has heretofore established a schedule of Fees, pursuant to Resolution No. 2010-02, which it is desirous of amending and updating;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Glenburn Township, and **IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by authority of the same, that the following schedule of fees shall apply from the effective date of this RESOLUTION:

If the costs involved in any sewage permit exceed the application fee charged, the excess will be billed to the applicant plus 10% handling charge by the township.

7. Site Evaluation Fee. For those who want written evidence that ground is Suitable for on-lot sewage, for planning and subdivision approvals. Includes backhoe and percolation test results which may be transferred to a new sewage permit application in the future.

8. Soil placement verification. Certifying, with a qualified soils scientist hired by the applicant, that good mineral soil has been added to a prescribed depth in a marked location in order that the area may be tested after a four year waiting period to determine if it is suitable for on-lot sewage use. The drainfield must be located in the same exact area. A new permit application must be applied for and new testing performed after a minimum four year interval, to ascertain if the replacement area is suitable for on-lot sewage use.

9. Minor planning module review.

\$150/lot

10. Major subdivision module review

\$100/lot

11. Appeals: appeals from the denial or granting of a sewage permit PLUS costs of advertising, court stenographer, and consultants hired y the Township.

\$1500 Plus costs incurred

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board is authorized to enter into an appropriate agreement with a Certified Sewage Enforcement Officer and an Alternate Certified Sewage Enforcement Officer, to enforce its duties as a Local Agency.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Glenburn Township on this 18th Day of April 2011. This schedule of fees supersedes a schedule of fees adopted April 19th, 2010.
