Minutes

Committee Reports

Roads: Monthly Road Report May/June 2019

In the previous 4 weeks the Road Crew have been doing their best to keep up with all the storm and rain damage that has occurred within the township. Most of the damage is in the form of erosion along ditches and roadways along with the leaching out of dirt roads or dirt driveways onto a lower road. They are working their way around the township repairing and cleaning up the roads as they go. The wet weather has impacted the amount of potholes that have formed within the township and they are out patching at least one full day a week. They have been working on the resurfacing of the dirt roads in the township. They have been on Wilson Ave, Tourist Ave, and Waterford Road that leads into Dalton. They will be working on the resurfacing of the other dirt roads as the weather permits them to. The Road Crew installed a catch basin on Waterford Road last week along with digging out ditches on Humphrey Street. They are working their way around the township cleaning and digging out ditches to help aid in storm water removal. They will be putting a ditch in on the left hand side of the upper part of Park Ave in the next few weeks to help aid in runoff of storm water and debris. As soon as they get a few dry days they are going to crack seal with the tar kettle throughout the township. They have plans to build up curbs that are made of asphalt on Wyndwood and Waterford Road to help keep storm water directed to catch basins. The Road Crew will be trimming back intersections as needed along with roadside growth. Hopefully the weather will regulate and let it all dry out.

Sewage Enforcement: Gary Wilding sent report regarding the Sewage Complaint on Sholcosky property regarding odor and water discoloration. Also runoff of water down the side of property. The water color may be an iron oxidized. This is not a township issue and suggest that Darlene and Brittany Sholcosky call PA DEP (Mike Sames). Also the other items discussed was the litter on the slopes, this is a civil matter between parties not a township issue. But The PADOT storm water system could possibly be a different matter.

The noted issues were discussed at the last visit and conducted to confirm the iron oxidation was not connected to the on-lot sewage disposal system at the Glenburn Grill.
