Supervisor Wicks recommended JP Mascaro come and meet with Supervisor Wicks to go over which part of township should be done on what days. This will allow the Township to inform the residents when to expect their cleanup.
- Roads- Supervisor Wicks reported that the bid process is being done with South Abington Township for the road work that is necessary for the township. Also, a grant application has been made for the dirt and gravel roads and low volume roads. Wicks informed the Board that the application was submitted last Fall by Roadmaster Mark Hopkins.
