MONTHLY MEETING  
August 28, 2024**

Supervisor Davis called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with the pledge to the flag.

**Public Comment Period:** Supervisor Davis asked if anyone is here that is not on the agenda.

Allison Hall of Pine Tree Drive asked about liability for the work being done on her driveway . Only six cars come up and down her road and the amount of money being spent to do the road and the widening of the Walking Trail. Supervisor Davis explained that the request came from the Countryside Conservancy for the widening of the Walking Trail. Mrs. Hall. feels that the neighbors all should have been contacted from the township before the project began, it has disrupted her business. She is also concerned because she had a new drainage pipe put in at the end of her driveway this year and now they are digging it up and redoing all the work. She would not have done all this work if she knew in advance. Supervisors advised her that it will all be an overall improvement. Supervisor Keisling told her that she would be pleased in the end. Supervisors will check with Zach Smith about the updates.

Wyndwood Road: Peter Tierney regarding the Storm drain across from his home . He spoke with Road Master Mark Hopkins regarding the drainage problem.

The water comes from the property across the street , the drainage pipe from the gutters goes into the storm drain. The water is going under the township road. Supervisor Davis will go with Mark and see what needs to be done and have Mark look at the drain and clean out if they can get to it. Maybe it could be rebuilt. The corrugated pipe that is there is old and very clogged up.

Park Blvd : Diana Fenwick and Eric Van Gorder regarding the water from the Water company property. She went to the county roads and bridges, and they do not have anything to do with the roads there. Then She went to Penn Dot, and they also told her they do not have anything to do with the roads in the township. Also called up State Representatives Haddock office. They are complaining that the leftover paving materials from the paving on Seamans Rd made the water rush down with more damage. The pictures were shown to the supervisor by Eric Van Gorder. Both entrances from the water company have drainage from the heavy rain. Dianna Fenwick asks why Seamans gets Paved and not Park Blvd? Supervisor Davis stated that residents thanked us for the paving work. Supervisor Davis said he will talk to Mark tomorrow. She also wanted to know who moved the big rocks.
